CWELCC PROGRAM

Canada Wide Early Learning & Child Care agreement signed March 2022 – goal is to subsidize childcare so parents pay \$10/day on average



MORE AFFORDABLE

Currently Childcare operators have reduced fees paid by parents to 52%





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What is Licensed Childcare?

Childcare agencies are licensed by the Ministry of Education and must adhere to the regulations set out in the Childcare and Early Years Act (CCEYA), 2014. Licensed agencies contract with childcare Providers to deliver childcare from their own private homes. Providers are independent contractors and can care for a maximum of 6 children at one time. The childcare agency is accountable to ensure that every home where childcare is delivered meets all standards as set out in the CCEYA.

Benefits of Licensed Home Childcare

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There are many benefits to licensed home childcare for parents – including:

- Flexible hours Wee Watch agencies offer part-time, before and after school care, weekends, evenings and in some cases overnight care – meeting the needs of today's working families
- Oversight and Safety homes must meet all standards set out (sanitary, nutrition, programming, safety). All Wee Watch homes are visited and inspected monthly (exceeding the Ministry requirement of once per quarter) by a RECE professional
- With smaller group sizes (no more than 6 children in a home) – children receive individualized attention to their development, less exposure to illness
- Community based because care is in the home and in the community, the homes typically reflect the diversity of the community
- Young children often transition better from their own homes to a home-based childcare setting vs more institutional environments such as a daycare centre, siblings can be in care together (vs different rooms by age like in a daycare centre)



What sets Wee Watch Apart From Other Agencies?
